Type in how much money you want to transfer from your Woodforest account to your Cash App balance. After entering the amount, tap the "Add" button to initiate the transfer. You will then be asked to confirm the transaction by entering your Cash App PIN or using Touch ID/Face ID if you have those features enabled.
