We also become engagement ambassadors, teach classes or workshops, facilitate special events, make visits to homebound seniors, and deliver meals to them. In 2021, we served 75 clients through our senior center and 85,540 through our emergency services. Every year, over 22,000 of our clients visit a doc, dentist, therapist or case worker in one of our clinics. Our Center for Employment Training graduates earn, on average, \$18/hr—almost \$2 more than DC's minimum wage. We foster regional and national coalitions that drive funding and attention towards eliminating the root causes of homelessness and poverty. Over 91 cents of every dollar donated to SOME directly supports our lifesaving mission. SOME offers both individuals and groups numerous opportunities to make meaningful, hands-on contributions to their community via volunteer positions and programs.
