
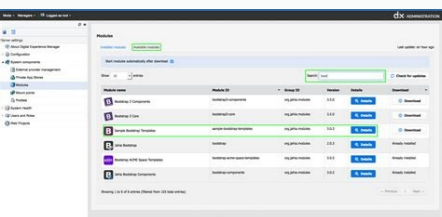
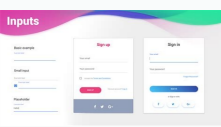
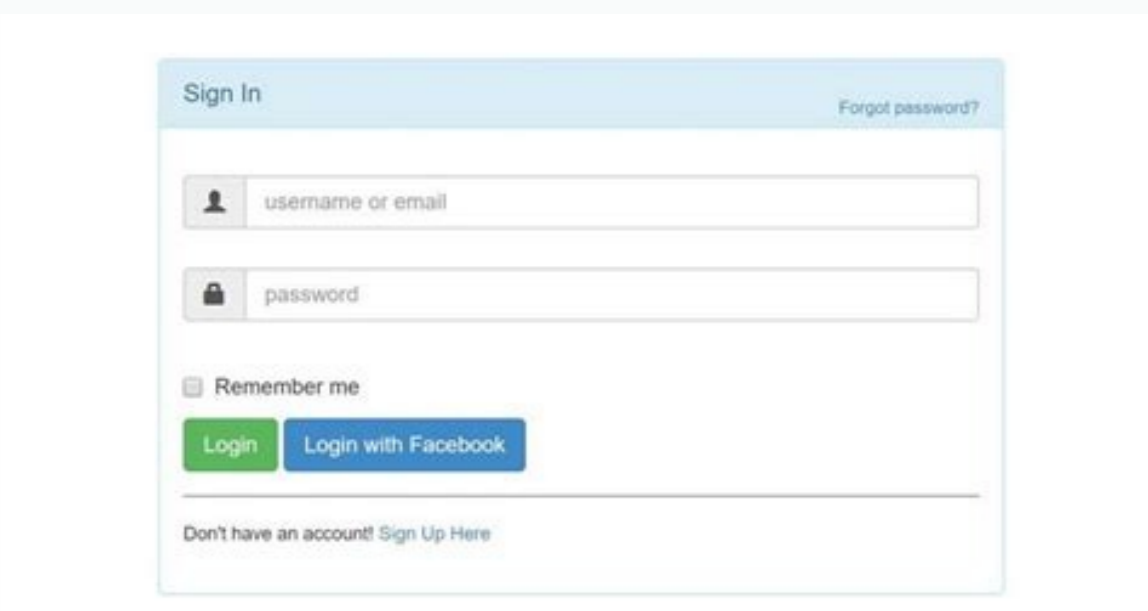
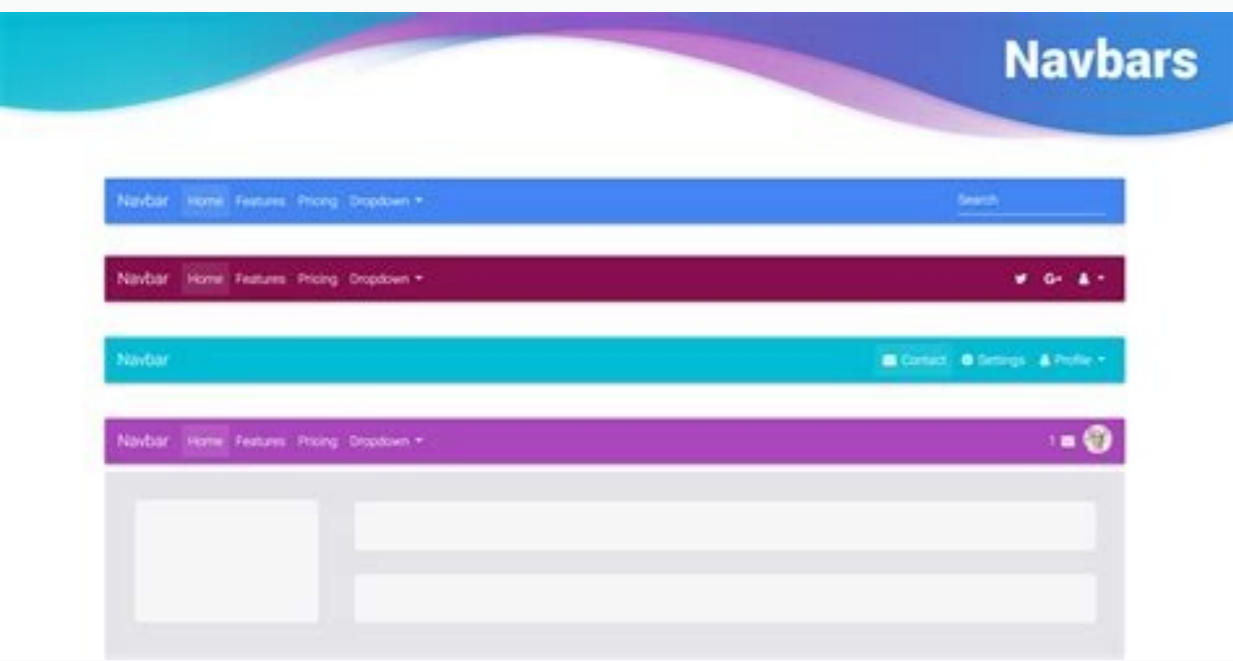


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Bootstrap button example template



The HTML code for this is a little trickier than the other examples so we'll walk through it slower. Here's the code for the button: `<button type="button" class="btn btn-primary">Click Me</button>` Here's the result: [Source](#) To make the button more visible (and clickable!) to visitors on the front end of your site, you can add modifier classes. On an account registration form, an info button might indicate that a user can click to edit their profile. `<button type="button" class="btn btn-light">Link</button>` The `btn-light` class was added when Bootstrap expanded its default color options. Bootstrap Button Styles As mentioned earlier, you can create new styles for your Bootstrap buttons by replacing any of the nine default modifier classes or by combining them with other classes. Let's take a closer look at these button design options below. `<button type="button" class="btn btn-link">Link</button>` Here is how these elements would appear on the front-end of your Bootstrap site. Adding Buttons to Your Bootstrap Site When designed and placed well, buttons can help persuade visitors to take action. Bootstrap Button Colors Using one of the default modifier classes will change the color of the text and background color of your buttons. Below let's take a look at the different code for each button state, and how they display on the front-end. This is especially important if they can't go back and change their information once they submit. Once clicked, these buttons will retain their darker background, darker border, and inset shadow.
