## Queen city academy

The Queen City Academy Charter School has a unique environment, with a small student body of around 24 students in the graduating class. This allows for closer relationships between teachers and students, but can also lead to limitations in terms of resources and facilities. The school's staff is described as supportive and helpful, but some students feel that the education could be improved. One student shares their experience, mentioning that while they appreciate the small community aspect, they often feel that the teaching styles don't cater well to high school students' needs. Another student criticizes the school for assigning high school-level work to 5th-grade students, which they find overwhelming and inappropriate. The school's facilities are described as basic, with only four classrooms in an apartment-like building. Queen City Academy Charter School is now officially open for new applicants, welcoming students for the 2025-2026 school year. However, there seems to be some confusion regarding the application process, which may only be available for new scholars and not returning ones. Despite its limitations, the school's small environment allows for closer relationships between teachers and students, which can have a positive impact on students' lives. One student shares their personal story of growth and self-discovery throughout their high school experience at Queen City Academy Charter School.
