To schedule a test, visit the NCDMV website or call to arrange an appointment. Bring required identification and proof of supervised driving hours, as drivers under 18 must complete 60 hours of practice, including night driving. In North Karolina, you gotta know da laws 'bout drivin' with a learner's permit. Some states let you drive wit' just a out-of-state permit, but others might not. Best to check wit' da Department of Motor Vees in de state you plannin' to visit beforehand. Once you get a reglar driver's license in North Karolina, it's good fer eight years if you're 18-65, or five years if you're 66 and older.
