Your local DMV offices provides many services including drivers license renewal, license plate renewal, getting a learners permit, and all the necessary DMV forms. Below is a list of all 67 Florida counties each of which has DMV offices. We recommend you attempt to complete your DMV needs online first as it may save you valuable time. By selecting a county from the list above you will see a variety of information including contact information for the local DMV offices, sheriff and police contact information, and the address for the Clerk of the circuit court. The county clerks office provides a wealth of information and services. Common services provided include marriage licenses, official county records, tax deed sales, recording of family trusts, and many others. Payments for traffic tickets, affidavits for traffic school, and case information are all managed by the clerk of court. Schedule Most DMV offices are only open from Monday to Friday. Typical office hours are from:8:30 to 4:30pm or 5:00pm But some counties have an office that opens earlier (7-15am) and stay open later (6:00pm) Check the location you are going to visit for their schedule. Services Not every DMV offices offers the same services. Example some DMV offices do not offer driving tests (road test) Check the location you are going to visit for their schedule. Starting on July 1, 2008 the State of Florida requires that new Motorcyclists (age 16 and older) must take and pass the Basic Rider Course (BRC) through the Florida Rider Training Program before they get a "Motorcycle Only" License or can have the Motorcycle Endorsement added to their current Drivers License. When you successfully completed the Basic Rider Course the sponsor will submit the results to the DMV electronically. There are two types of motorcycle drivers licenses in Florida. You must have one of the following if you are going to operate a two or three wheel motorcycle that has an engine over 50 cc. Motorcycle Endorsement If you already have a Florida Drivers License then you can get a Motorcycle Endorsement on your current drivers license. To obtain your Motorcycle Endorsement you must show proof that you have completed the Florida Rider Program. Motorcycle Only License To get a Motorcycle Only License you must be at least 16 years old and have held a Learners Permit for at least a year with no traffic convictions. If you are age 18 or older you are not required to have held a learners permit. You must pass the standard class E operators license test that all drivers take to get a drivers license and complete the Basic Riders Course. Three Wheel Motorcycles To operate a three wheel motorcycle you must complete the S/TEP - Sidecar / Trike Evaluation Program. This course provides basic skills for those operating three wheel motorcycles and side car rigs. Those who pass the Motorcycle S/TEP course will have an "S" restriction on their license. The S Restriction indicates that the person only has permission to operate a three wheeled motorcycle. Temporary Instruction Permit To Operate a Motorcycle As of July 1, 2008 NO temporary permits are issued by the State of Florida. Florida Helmet Laws If you are 21 years old and covered by an insurance policy with at least \$10,000 in medical benefits you can get a helmet exemption. However law enforcement may stop you if you are not wearing a helmet if they believe you are under 21. Questions about Getting a Motorcycle License? Contact your Local DMV Office. Shortcuts The Florida DMV has an online appointment system designed to make it easy to schedule appointments for many DMV services. Getting an appointment at a DMV office is a good idea to reduce your wait time. If possible try to complete your DMV needs online the online renewal system GoRenew may be your best choice. The FL DMV online appointment system is very easy to use and walks you through the process of making an appointment. As you walk through the appointment process the system provides useful information based on your selection. For example if you select first time license, written test, the system will provide links to the requirements for obtaining a Florida Drivers License. Citizenship Status The first step is to indicate your citizenship status. Be aware that regardless of your status you will be required to provide the proper identification to confirm your status. You will select from the following: U.S. Citizen Immigrant (Resident Alien) Non-Immigrant (Non-Resident Alien or Visitor) DMV Service Type Next is to select the FL DMV service type you need for an appointment. You will select from the following: Written Tests and Renewal Services Driving Tests Other Services DMV Written tests address many topics; a few examples include CDL (Commercial Drivers License), Motorcycle License, and tests to renew a Florida License. Driving tests that can be scheduled include CDL (basic, pre-trip and skills), Class D and E Drivers Licenses, and Motorcycle Skills. Once you have selected your service type and the specific FL DMV service you are scheduling you will enter your personal information including your name, date of birth, gender, phone number, county, and email address. Choose Your County and FL DMV Office The DMV appointment system will prompt you to select the DMV Office where you wish to complete your appointment. If there are multiple offices in your county you may have the opportunity to select the office closest to you. When you specify the FL DMV office you will be presented with a calendar to choose your appointment date. Select an Appointment Date and Time The FL DMV appointment system tracks the days that are available for the service you are scheduling and presents you with a list of available days. If there are no appointments available in the current month you can move the calendar forward until you see a date with an available appointment. When you select a date you are presented with a list of available times. Confirm Your Information After selecting the type of appointment, Florida DMV office location, the date and time the system presents a summary of all your information and allows you to make any corrections or continue and schedule your appointment. When you confirm your information is correct you are presented with a confirmation screen that you should print. The FL DMV appointment system confirmation reminds you to arrive at least 15 minutes before your appointment and warns that failure to show up on time will result in cancellation of your appointment. Also included is a personal identification number that you can use to cancel your appointment. This website is privately owned and is not affiliated with the FLHSMV. A Commercial Drivers License is required in Florida for any driver operating a tractor/trailer with a declared weight of 26,001 pounds or more. Below are the different classes of commercial drivers license. Shortcut: Commercial Drivers License (CDL) Handbook Online Note: Commercial Driver Licenses (CDL), Valid in Florida Only Licenses and licenses expired over one year cannot be renewed online, by phone, or by mail. (Note: Proof of citizenship or legal presence may be required for renewal, duplicate or replacement licenses. Please come prepared to present an identification document as proof of citizenship or legal presence.) Check our Driver License Office Directory for addresses, telephone numbers, days and operating hours. Appointments are recommended. Commercial Drivers License (CDL) CLASS A: Any tractor/trailer combination that has an actual weight, declared weight or GVWR of 26,001 pounds or more. provided towed vehicle is more than 10,000 pounds. CLASS B: Any single motor vehicle that has an actual weight, declared weight or GVWR of 26,001 pounds or more, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle of 10,000 pounds or less. CLASS C: Any motor vehicle that has an actual weight, declared weight or GVWR of less than 26,001 pounds when endorsements "H" or "P" would be required on the driver license OR any combination of motor vehicles where the towing vehicle is less than 26,001 pounds. GVWR and the towed vehicle has a GVWR of 10,000 pounds or less, but together they weigh 26,001 pounds or more.
