Many cases of emotional maltreatment and abuse go unreported each year because children and youth may not be aware that it is happening to them. Other forms of abuse such as physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, or exposure to violence are more readily known about and easier to label and understand. Emotional maltreatment, however, is much harder to identify and define. One broad and general definition of emotional [abuse](#) states emotional maltreatment “involves acts or omissions by those in contact with a child that are likely to have serious, negative, emotional impact” (Ministry of Child and Family Development). This definition can be interpreted many different ways depending on your culture, background, or history. If we compare the two lowest percentages of substantiated child maltreatment cases in 2008, sexual abuse made up 6% and emotional maltreatment accounted for 9% of these cases (Public Health Agency of Canada, 2010). Sexual abuse has a clear and easy to understand definition, whereas emotion abuse is still left to so much interpretation yet accounts for more substantiated cases. More research on emotional maltreatment and abuse and a clearer definition is needed.

When children are born, they rely on our parents or immediate caregivers to give them the essentials such as shelter, clothing, and the food needed to survive. It is crucial for a child to feel secure attachment and require those around them to treat them in such a way that

fosters a healthy emotional and mental state. As children and adolescents they should expect to be raised in an environment that is free from abuse, and in an environment that only has their best interest at heart. Sadly this is not always the case.

...th is being mistreated, we need to advocate on the child's behalf for what the child or youth needs. Being able to identify and define emotional maltreatment is crucial in getting the correct kind of support for those we work with. Since this form of abuse is the hardest to identify, define and therefore the hardest to bring legal action against, our CYCC role will be extremely important in the world of the abused child or youth. A child or youth may need to be referred to a professional in dealing with the abuse, or just being a friendly ear for the child or youth to express and work through their feelings might be useful. In order to prevent any long lasting mental health issues such as depression, anxiety or PTSD a clear definition of emotional abuse and action plan is required coupled with our support as a CYCC for those suffering through this is crucial.
