Immigration during the period from the 16th to the 18th century dominated the world scene. While many immigrants from Europe immigrated to the New World in search of individualistic freedoms from their respective countries, the vast majority of people moved to colonial America due to their forceful removal of their native homelands. The search of new religious freedoms, the population influx of Africans into the New World, and the need for more slaves to cultivate crops contributed to the major diaspora into the New World.

The issue of religion was very divisive in [England](#) during the 16th century. Each individual pew of a church could be filled with “saints” and “the damned” (American Pageant 44). The internal dissatisfaction between groups caused many people to separate themselves from the Church of England. The animosity between the English people spilled over into a physical confrontation. The Thirty Year War that lasted from 1618-1648 included Protestants and Catholics. The very nature of religion was tested due to those wars. Subsequently, the Puritans decided to practice religion freely. Seventy thousand Puritans/Separatists voyaged to the West Indies and New England from 1630-1642. Puritan leader John Winthrop felt that he and his follower’s eternal salvation would be compromised if they did not fully devote themselves to the Lord (Document 4). Puritans felt that continuing their worship in a divided Church of England would be a deterrent to their

overall goal -- serving the Lord. The fear of being sent to hell superseded any animosity the Puritans had for the other parishioners of the Church of England. Therefore, Puritans felt compelled to worship alone in the New World.

The reasons behind the massive immigration to the New World would transform the entire world. The original intent of immigrating to America was to gain freedom. Freedom from oppressive taxes, freedom to worship openly, and the freedom to expand their horizons (land) caused millions of people to travel to America in hopes of a better life. Spiritually, the motives behind the Puritans departure from England would shape the first amendment of the Bill of Rights. Economically, the new nation of America would be impacted by the production of tobacco. The notion of living cheaper would depend on the hard labor of thousands of slaves in America. Eventually, the motive of immigrating would relate to freedom. Slaves did not gain their freedom until 1863 under the Emancipation Proclamation. However, the immigration of millions would result in their freedom in America.
