In this course we have had a brief but informative insight into the roles of government, and the Supreme Court. In the eighteenth century our founding fathers created a new democracy and in that new democracy it seems that they wanted an apolitical Supreme Court to fit into that scenario. "However it is debatable whether or not a Supreme Court that is appointed by the President can ever truly be independent from political influences" (Biggs). In the past and
