Laws in most states require school attendance until graduation or until kids are the age 16, most high schools require attendance until the age of 17 or 18 . Conversely, students who fail a grade may stay in high school past the age of 18. Usually students over 19 attend remedial classes to receive a high school diploma or General Educational Development (GED) certificate. Each state's laws vary on the cut-off age for students to get free public education services. Many states have adult high schools for people generally 18 and over. While other students can stay in high school past the age of 18 if it is deemed appropriate by that school. On average, 71% of American students earn a high school diploma. A high school diploma or GED certificate is usually required for entrance into a two or four-year college or university or other post-secondary education programs. High schools can usually be sub-divided as general education high schools, vocational schools, magnet schools, college preparatory high schools or alternative high

schools. Most high schools are general education high schools.
