The FBI that same year showed that guns were used in 68 percent of homicides, 41 percent of robbery offenses and 21 percent of aggravated assaults nationwide (Office of Justice Programs). "More than 500 children die annually from accidental gunshots. Some shoot themselves, while others kill friends or siblings after discovering a gun" (Momlogic). Gun-control laws can't

stop a criminal and, guns in your home, used for defense, can be harmful. The United States can do a few things to help without making more firearm laws.
