Michael Manning M.D., author of *Euthanasia and Physician-Assisted Suicide: Killing or Caring?* states that euthanasia is "Intentionally administering medications to cause the patient's death at the their request and with full, informed consent" (M.Manning). There are four different and distinct types of euthanasia; voluntary, involuntary, active, and passive. Voluntary euthanasia is when a competent patient makes an enduring request to die. This type of euthanasia is in direct contrast to involuntary, which is done without the patient's permission. This would mean ending a patient's life without their knowledge, this would be used when a patient is in a

coma or on life support.
