From the mining to burning, coal creates large amounts of pollution, and damages the environment. "Clean Coal" is a myth, there is only less dirty coal. This is why fracking should be used to obtain other fuels, which are cleaner. Fracking is a process in which different fluids are pumped into the earth at high pressures to drill a hole. Horizontal fracking is when after they reach a certain depth, the nozzle makes a ninety degree turn to reach areas that were previously unreachable. Once the deposit is reached, the fluid is pumped back out. The fluid is mostly water mixed with a proppant like sand or small ceramic balls with some lubricating chemicals.. Horizontal fracking was developed by George Mitchell in 1998. He discovered the correct combination of horizontal drilling, pressure, and proppants to get gas flowing out of the shale (Merrill 972-973). Fracking should be used because it allows access to more fuel deposits, creates jobs and can lower or pay living expenses, and has a low risk to contamination.

Horizontal fracking allows power plants to reach previously unreachable fuel supplies. They are unreachable because of the surroundings, "many deposits are located near houses or under bodies of water, using horizontal fracking, it is possible to access these deposits more easily". The companies cannot just demolish houses or drain lakes, so they use horizontal fracking to reach those deposits. The majority of new wells are already hydraulically fracked (Mooney). This is due to the ability of the fracking to reach those

sources. Fracking can be used to obtain petroleum, natural gas, geothermal, and any other non-solid fuels. Natural gas is a much cleaner and more abundant fuel source than [coal](#). Using fracking, five-hundred ...
