Once youve applied your changes, you may be disconnected. Youll need to use your new password to re-connect to the WiFi network. If you still see the WiFi modem settings, selectLogout. If you're connected using an Ethernet cable, disconnect it from your device and from your modem so that you can test your WiFi's connectivity. Connect to your WiFi network and, once youre online, check at least 2 different websites to make sure your WiFi is working properly. The name of your wireless network, known as the SSID, is used to identify your network apart from other wireless networks that are in range of your device. To change the name of the wireless network (SSID) on your Wireless Modem, you will need to log into the admin console which will allow you to configure various settings related to your wireless network. Did you know? SSID stands for Service Set Identifier and consists of a sequence of characters that uniquely names a wireless local area network (WLAN). SSID is also known as your network name or your wireless network name. To change the wireless network name on your Arris Advanced WiFi modem: Enter 192.168.0.1 in your web browser's address bar. Log in to the modem with the following information: Password: Use the password printed on a sticker on your modem. In the Quick Start Wizard, select Manage Wi-Fi Network. Select the 5 GHz tab, if you are changing the network name of your 5 GHz network. Next to Network Name (SSID), enter a new WiFi network name. Select Apply to save your changes. To change the password for the wireless network on your wireless modem, you will need to log into the admin console of your WiFi modem which will allow you to configure various settings related to your wireless network. You can do this over WiFi, but a wired connection will offer the most reliable experience.
